During Capstone Camp, campers will be divided into two or more teams and each day the teams will compete in a variety of Extreme Events (not all events will be athletic). During the rest of the time campers will experience great Camp Dixie activities: canoeing, kayaking, archery, Bible Study and much, much more! This is an overnight week-long camp \$290 (\$265 before April 1st)

Kayaks and Canoes are available with a special waiver (bring your own lifeguard).
