## Camp Dixie Retreat Cleaning Guidelines

Please assist us in keeping Camp Dixie clean for future guests. Please leave Camp Dixie as clean, or cleaner than you found it when you arrived!

- 1. Pick up and empty all trash. Please take tied garbage bags to the dumpster, which is located at the western side of the property near the road.
- 2. All furniture, tables and chairs must be moved back into place as you found them when you arrived. Chairs in the Dining Hall must be stacked on the tables, 6 chairs to a long table, 4 chairs to a short table. Please wash tabletops before placing chairs on them
- 3. Sweep all floors and showers.
- 4. Mop bathrooms, kitchen, and Dining Hall using floor cleaner from the kitchen. Do not walk on the floors after they have been mopped until they are dry.
- 5. If your group used the kitchen, please clean kitchen counters, the steam table, and stovetop. Check the microwave to make sure the inside is clean. Wash all dishes and return them where you found them. Make sure to empty the refrigerators before you leave.
- 6. Check for any items that may be left behind.
- 7. Say good-bye to your retreat host before you leave!
