

Camp Dixie Retreat

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can we please turn up the heat or turn down the air conditioning?

You can heat or cool the rooms to your desired temperature, however please do not set the Air Conditioning below 65 degrees or turn the heat above 80 degrees. AC and heat is an “all or nothing” kind of machine. If it’s running, it’s trying to heat or cool. Setting the temperature lower or higher will not cool or heat the room more quickly.

2. Where can we bring our garbage?

Camp has a green colored dumpster in the back of the property past the Director’s house. All of your garbage should be placed in the dumpster before you leave.

3. What should we clean before we leave?

Everything was clean when you arrived so please make sure it is clean when you leave. Inside this packet is a cleaning guideline for you to follow before you leave. You can find all the cleaning supplies in the closet by the piano. If you have any questions please ask your retreat host.

4. What should we do when we are ready to check out?

Please let your retreat host know what time you are planning to leave. That way the host can check the facilities for cleanliness, and speak with you about the retreat. If you have any final questions they can be answered at that time.

5. I need more room in the Dining Hall, can I move the tables?

Yes, please feel free to move the tables and chairs; however, please place them back into their original places with chairs stacked on top before you leave. The retreat leader’s handbook has a map of where the tables should be placed.

6. Perdido Bay is beautiful, can I go for a swim?

Yes, however it is strict Camp Dixie policy that any use of the waterfront requires a lifeguard. You can supply your own, or sign a release waiver, or Camp Dixie can provide one for \$15 an hour. If you would like to use the canoes, there is a rental fee of \$5.00 per-canoe per-day. Everyone (adult and child alike) are required to wear a lifejacket when in a canoe.
